



### APPLICATION FOR ENGLISH HONORS IN THE MAJOR

Candidates for Honors in the Major/English must submit the following information:

- Application Form (this form)
- Degree Audit
- Personal Statement (a brief essay explaining why you are interested in pursuing Honors in English and mentioning any special circumstances that should be considered in evaluating this application)
- A letter of nomination from a faculty member
- One piece of written work (not to exceed 25 pages)

After you receive approval from the English Department, you must make separate application to the Burnett Honors College (contact BHC for the form <http://www.honors.ucf.edu/>).

In order to graduate with Honors in the Major, you will need to complete

- One semester of directed readings
- At least one semester of thesis hours (which cannot be taken until the directed readings semester is successfully completed)
- One 5000-level graduate course
- A successful thesis defense
